Your child has been invited to attend the Food and Fun Summer Programme 2025 at Ysgol Treffynnon. This is an initiative funded by the Welsh Local Government Association delivered in schools throughout Wales during the summer holidays. In Flintshire there are twelve schools delivering the programme this year which is coordinated by Flintshire County Council.

The Food and Fun Summer Programme is open to current Year 7 pupils at Ysgol Treffynnon and Year 6's transitioning to high school. The programme will take place over twelve dates, free of charge for up to forty children. The programme takes place on the school site and will be delivered by school staff. Free breakfast and lunch is provided each day and there are opportunities to learn about healthy eating and cooking activities. There are sport and physical activity sessions each day alongside a range of enrichment activities delivered by partner organisations. All activities will support positive communication and teamwork and promote their health and wellbeing. Pupils are encouraged to wear clothing appropriate for taking part in sport and bring water bottles each day.

Key partners involved in the coordination and delivery of the programme include: Flintshire Healthy Schools Scheme, Newydd Catering and Cleaning, GWELLA and Betsi Cadwalader University Health Board Dietetics team. All staff have completed relevant Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks and there will be a minimum of one qualified first aider on site and all staff will have received relevant safeguarding training for their roles.

There is a maximum number of 40 places available for the summer scheme at Ysgol Treffynnon. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and we will operate a waiting list should any places become available prior to, or during the programme.

There is an expectation that your child attends all 12 sessions where possible. Please inform the Food and Fun Coordinator if your child is unable to attend any sessions. If your child does not attend for 3 consecutive days without informing the Co-ordinator, their place will be allocated to another child.
