We are writing to inform you about the upcoming and exciting schedule of events in Ysgol Treffynnon's annual Year 6 transition/induction programme.

The first event is the **Year 6 parents' meeting which takes place on Thursday 5th June 2025. The meeting will start at 4.30pm and end at 5.30pm.** It will be held in the main hall at Ysgol Maes Y Felin.
